Subject:- Suspension of functioning of Appellate Tribunal till 31.05.2020.

In continuation and in partial modification of earlier orders dated 16-03-2020, 23-03-2020 and 26-03-2020 on Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) and in view of Ministry of Home Affairs orders No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 23-03-2020, dated 15-04-2020 & dated 17-05-2020 and further extension of lockdown for the period of two weeks w.e.f. 18-05-2020 to 31-05-2020. It has been decided to take the further precautionary measure: –



2 It is to clarify that the interim order of stay/status quo, if any, already passed in any appeal/appeals, to continue till the next date of hearing.

The limitation period for filing of appeal would be considered as per the judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the order dated 23-03-2020 in the matter of suo-moto writ petition(civil) No. (S).3/2020 regarding Cognizance for extension of limitation.
