Office Order

Subject:- Suspension of physical functioning of Court hearing of the Appellate Tribunal till 30-11-2020.

In view of the ongoing situation of the pandemic corona virus (2019-nCoV) in the NCT of Delhi, Hon'ble Delhi High Court Order No. 500/RG/DHC/2020 dated 08.10.2020 read with office Memorandum of DOP&T in F.No. 11013/9/2014-Estt.A.III dated 07.10.2020, it is decided by the Competent Authority to have limited functioning of urgent matters by virtual hearings.

Keeping in view the shortage of space, it is very difficult to maintain social distancing if regular physical hearings of appeals are taken up. Virtual hearing would be held with the consent of Advocates of both the parties and this limited functioning is upto 30.11.2020 in urgent matters and the matters ordered by Hon'ble the Supreme Court/High Court. The present arrangement of hearing would continue in the same manner as is continuing vide this Tribunal notification dated 30-09-2020, 08-09-2020 and 17-08-2020. As the only Member is functioning in the Tribunal so there will not be any simultaneous Physical Hearing/Virtual Hearing. In the above circumstances, this Tribunal will have limited functioning from 02.11.2020 to 13.11.2020 in urgent matters only. Accordingly, the matters which are listed on following dates are hereby adjourned to the dates mentioned against the dates already fixed subject to exception in respect of the matters mentioned below.
