Office Order

Subject:- Suspension of physical functioning of Court hearing of the Appellate Tribunal till 12-02-2021.

In view of the ongoing situation of the pandemic corona virus (2019-COVID) in the NCT of Delhi and Office Memorandum of DOP&T in F.No. 11013/9/2014-Estt.A.III dated 07.10.2020, it is decided by the Competent Authority to have limited functioning of urgent matters only by way of virtual hearings.

Keeping in view the shortage of space, it is very difficult to maintain social distancing if regular physical hearings of appeals are taken up. To avoid any untoward incident of transmission of COVID-19, only virtual hearings will be held till 12.02.2021. Due to space constraints, it is practically impossible to hold physical hearing. Virtual hearings would be held with the consent of Advocates of both the parties and this limited functioning is up to 12.02.2021 in urgent matters only. The present arrangement of hearing would continue in the same manner as is continuing vide this Tribunal notification dated 15.01.2021, 31.12.2020, 27.11.2020, 13-11-2020, 29-10-2020, 30-09-2020, 08-09-2020 and 17-08-2020. As the only Member is functioning in the Tribunal so there will not be any simultaneous Physical Hearing/Virtual Hearing. In the above circumstances, this Tribunal will have limited functioning from 01.02.2021 to 12.02.2021 in urgent matters including High Court directed matters only. Accordingly, the matters which are listed on following dates are hereby adjourned to the dates mentioned against the dates already fixed subject to exception in respect of the matters mentioned below.

The hearing of all the regular matters/appeals in the Appellate Tribunal stand adjourned to the following dates for the date fixed:-
