**Subject:- Suspension of functioning of Appellate Tribunal till 17.05.2020.**

In continuation and in partial modification of earlier orders dated 16-03-2020, 23-03-2020, 26-03-2020 & 15-04-2020 on Noval Corona Virus (COVID-19) and in view of Ministry of Home Affairs orders No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 23-03-2020, 15-04-2020 and 01-05-2020 by Ministry of Home Affairs lockdown has been further extended for two weeks w.e.f 04-05-2020 upto 17-05-2020. It has been decided to take the further precautionary measure: –

2. It is to clarify that the interim order of stay/status quo, if any, already passed in any appeal/appeals, to continue till the next date of hearing.

It is further requested in the case of extreme urgent matters, the parties are required to provide brief input as to why the application/appeal is urgently to be listed/ to be heard urgently by Hon'ble Acting Chairman, ATFP on the email Id of the Appellate Tribunal i.e. [registrar-atfp@gov.in](mailto:registrar-atfp@gov.in) and also provide the copy of notice issued under section 8(4) of PMLA/demand notice under PBPT/FEMA if any.

4. The filing of appeals during the period may be avoided due to complete lockdown declared by Government of India and to prevent spreading of Corona Virus. The limitation period for filing of appeal would be considered as per the judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the order dated 23-03-2020 in the matter of suo-moto writ petition(civil) No. (S).3/2020 regarding Cognizance for extension of limitation.
