Subject:- Suspension of functioning of Appellate Tribunal till 31.07.2020.

In continuation and in partial modification of earlier orders dated 16-03-2020, 23-03-2020 26-03-2020 and 18-05-2020 on Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) and in view of Ministry of Home Affairs orders No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 23-03-2020, 15-04-2020 and 17-05-2020.
